After choosing the name, it was registered as a non profit organization. NIRA started in 2008 when we signed MoU with NITDA on behalf of the Federal Government of Nigeria but the re-delegation of .ng to NIRA happened around May 2009 but the full take off of .ng came around July-September 2009. Our pioneer President passed on when I was the Vice President then and after that an election was conducted in 2010 and I became the President. We took over .nig when it had about two thousand (2000) domain names and since then we had had over 40,000 (forty thousand) domain names registered on the registry.


