**E-Newsletter:** Sir, what can you tell us about the future of civil engineering?

Vassilis: We are in a critical phase with important challenges in front of us. The first is the development of sustainable infrastructure in transportation such as roads, airports and seaports. The second is in the building. In this sector we need to use the standards for energy efficiency in buildings and the use of renewable energy from solar power. Agricultural development is a special field that involves

engineers who design and build infrastructures for agricultural development such as water supply, irrigation, waste water treatment to produce biogas from solid waste, etc. We should face all of these challenges first. Governments should support public and private investors for the building development, operation and maintenance of infrastructures. We also face the challenge of innovation which needs to be applied in all fields of engineering. Also, in internationalization, we should think global and not only for our national economies but for the world as a whole. If this is done we will see that the answer to growth and development is Investment, Innovation and Internationalization.
