Engr. Adurahaman Mohammed, is the Chapter Chairman of Nigerian Society of Chemical Engineers in Abuja and Nassarawa.

E-Newsletter: Sir, what do you have to say about chemical engineering practice in our region?

Adurahaman: There areas where there are industries and people are there practicing and we have areas where there are people and there are no industries especially in the Federal Capital Territory and its environs. There are no industries there and

chemical engineers after graduation are living there and there are no jobs. That is the major problem we are facing in this FCT and its environs. We don't have industries so it is very difficult for any chemical engineer to operate where there is no process industry.

E-Newsletter: What do you think can be done to solve this issue?

Adurahaman: A lot of things can be done in solving this prob-

lem. One is to first of all identify the raw materials around these areas, then the second thing is to process the raw materials, to make sure that there are process industries all around. To give an example, agro allied industry will produce lots of tomatoes here. If you go to Benue, coming down to FCT and go down to Niger, there are lots of things they produce and there are lots of mineral resources there. What we need to put in is to make sure that there are industries that will process these raw materials and with this a lot of people will get jobs.

E-Newsletter: Who do you think can get this done, the private sector or the government?

Adurahaman: Both the private sector and the government. They must come together to get it done. The private sector must bring out the money. Instead of the people in this area going into estate, people should go into industries and produce something. It is not only estate they should go into industry, identify raw materials, process them and produce something.
