## Interview with Engr. P. N. Edeh, FNSE

Engr. P. N. Edeh FNSE, is the Chairman of the Nigerian Society of Engineers Enugu Branch.

E-Newsletter: Sir, what do you have to say regarding portable water supply?

Edeh: We have a problem in all departments of water supply. We have a wrong conception that water is free. Somebody said that God gave water freely but the pipes and the pumps didn't come with the water. Water needs to get to the people at the right places and at the right quality. That is the main

problem. We can't do without water. It is on the government to improve on the processes of water supply and it should be proper- E-Newsletter: Thank you sir. ly managed. If water is supplied sufficiently and efficiently, the commercial department will be able to collect revenue and with

that be able to operate and maintain the water supply system. One challenge we have is when a system is newly installed, it will operate fine at the beginning but after some time it collapses because the preventive maintenance practices are not done.

E-Newsletter: Is it wrong for people to drill their own boreholes to get water?

Edeh: It is wrong. There should be a form of regulation and control. The control is relaxed because the agency that is responsible to ensure that water is available have failed in their responsibilities and since people need water, they get it at all cost. So there is need to properly inform people when they want to install their own water supply facilities. The disposal of our wastes are underground through septic tanks and if we have water supply systems very close to these septic tanks lives will be endangered.
