E-Newsletter: Sir, as the

Chairman House Committee on ICT, what can you tell us about ICT in the country and where you think it will be in the next four years?

Hon. Gusau: Been the Chairman House Committee on ICT, it is a brand new committee which has not existed before now but on the President's creation of the ICT Ministry, it became apparent that a new committee has to be put in place to oversee the ICT activities and as an oversight function. So we expect to extend ICT beyond reasonable expectations as oversight and see to it that penetration of ICT into different parts of localities in Nigeria is achieved in the period we are given.

E-Newsletter: Sir, how do you think this will be achieved? How do you get the rural areas involved?

Hon. Gusau: You see it is just a matter of working together and I think we are beginning to have a rethink between us, the ministry and the parastatals. It is all about working in harmony; in the sense that we know what they are doing and they know what we are doing. For example, our legislators will legislate on budget issues and make sure that oversights are carried out on what the parastatals under the Ministry of ICT say they want to spend their budget on. They in turn will make sure that it is done and you see, it is the matter of carrying every one along.

They will inform us of what they intend to do and we will sit down and have a look at it. We will have an agreement and see that it is viable. This is an important issue to be done in the country.

E-Newsletter: Thank you very much sir. If we have the ICT infrastructure in place and we do not have enough bandwidth, it is going to be challenging. People cannot do video conferencing, voice conferencing and all that, how can the bandwidth issue be tackled? You know bandwidth is very expensive looking at the cost.

Hon. Gusau: In a matter of weeks Nigeria, will launch another satellite. It is a communication satellite, so the bandwidth issues you are talking about will be a thing of the past because you will have so much you can play around with. It is not the matter of only capacity building, it is also a matter of registering the infrastructure. So with that Nigeria will have so enough bandwidth and believe you me this is going to be launched in December. So we are not talking about years to come or months to come, this is just next month. This is our hope and off course with a lot of bandwidth and capacities what will remain will be capacity building; making sure that a lot of qualified engineers are being produced to man the infrastructure. We are all


