

## Interview with Engr. Prof. Mobolaji Aluko

Engr. Prof. Mobolaji Aluko, is the Vice Chancellor of Federal University Otuoke, Bayelsa State.

**E-Newsletter:** Sir, do we really have good internet access in terms of coverage, broadband, infrastructure?

**Prof. Aluko:** I am not sure the number of people who have access to the internet. I don't have all the figures but I understand that it's



much better but our internet access can be better. You know it costs a lot for people to be on the good internet.

**E-Newsletter:** What do you think can be done to improve the internet infrastructure?

**Prof. Aluko:** First access has to be there and there are only three ways of access which are fiber, radio and satellite and each one of them must be increased which means there has to be an increase of infrastructure. That is availability and accessibility. The next thing should be affordability. It is the affordability that will determine how many people that will get it.

**E-Newsletter:** Looking at our universities with the kind of internet access they have, what can be done to improve it?

**Prof. Aluko:** Well, there is always a statement of fiber or multiple fiber lanes across the country. I think there should be a policy that should state that every fiber lane that is within 20-30 miles to a university, such should be connected to the university and the university can take charge of what happens inside their campuses. Also, there should be what I would call FTTU (Fiber To The Universities) project, where you will look at the map of the country, see where the fibers are laid and deliberately ensure that fibers are laid to universities because there more than 100 universities in the country as we speak. We should have all the universities mapped out and ensure that there are fiber connections to some gates and charge the universities to make the best use of it. Laying that infrastructure using this FTTU project would be something that will be of great help.
